LCA is known for having one of the best environments for competition around. Our opponents consistently tell us how much they appreciate the sportsmanship of our athletes, the conduct/behavior of our fans, and the friendliness of everyone they come in contact with.

Please be reminded of the expectations for conduct and share these with any family/friends that may be attending a game with you. These expectations apply to both home and away games.

Code of Conduct Expectations:

- We cheer *for* our team, not *against* the opposing team or an opposing player.
- Air horns, whistles, or other similar devices that simulate the sounds of clock horns or officials' whistles are prohibited.
- Derogatory, inflammatory, or profane language is prohibited.
- Coaching your child from the stands is prohibited. Coaches to do that.
- Addressing the coach(es) from the stands is prohibited. An appointment may be schedule to discuss any concern.
- Addressing the officials is prohibited. Coaches to do that.
- We show ownership for our field of play. Each person does his/her part to clean up the area around him/her at the end of the contest. Trash cans and recycling containers are located at each facility.
